Position Summary

A YMCA lifeguard monitors pool activities and ensures member safety. Lifeguards need to possess knowledge of rescue procedures and emergency medical procedures. To help prevent incidents, lifeguards must enforce all safety guidelines as outlined by the YMCA. To ensure safety, lifeguards must remain alert throughout an entire shift.

Applicant must hold lifeguard and CPR certification. A lifeguard may need to possess a pre-employment physical and a skills test. Additional job duties a lifeguard performs include preparing activity and incident reports and performing pool maintenance.

Lifeguards must perform their duties in accordance with the policies, goals, mission, values and objectives established by the Family YMCA of NW IL.

Responsibilities

- Monitor pool activities
- Enforce safety guidelines
- On deck monitoring of swim lessons
- Is familiar with opening, closing and emergency procedures.
- Takes ownership of any problems that arise and resolves them in a professional manner.

Requirements

- Must have lifeguard and CPR certification
- Ability to stand, sit, walk, and occasionally lift and/or move up to 25 lbs

Performance Objectives

- Exceed the expectations of our members and guests everyday
- All emergencies or accidents are reported immediately to parents, supervisor or Director on Duty
- Teach and role model our mission and vision
